



Cornerstone Vista Product Information

The purpose of this document is to provide general information on the functionality of Cornerstone Vista version 2.0

Differences in Functionality in Cornerstone Vista:

- OOPS Operations:
 - OOPS Functionality is not included in Cornerstone Vista 2.0
- Keyboard Mouse Disable
 - Cornerstone Vista is not capable of disabling the Keyboard and Mouse on a Cornerstone Vista client.
- Multiple Passwords
 - Passwords cannot be added, removed, or changed locally at the client, but can be managed through the CCC. The client can be managed with the additional password as in the previous versions.
- Delayed Reboot/ Shutdown
 - The delayed reboot/ shutdown feature when used with Cornerstone Vista does not prompt the clients of the impending shutdown, or give an option to further delay; however the client will shut down or reboot in 120 seconds.
- Command Line Interface
 - Cornerstone Vista cannot be controlled through the Command line.
- Remote Execute
 - The remote Execute feature of Cornerstone Vista functions, but with some limitations. Due to added security features in Vista if an executable requires User input, or displays a GUI, it will run in an “Interactive Services Mode” which will usually prevent the script from functioning properly. Scripts that do not require user interaction, and perform all tasks in the background with no user notification should still function properly.
- Unattended Install
 - Cornerstone Vista 2.0 does not have unattended install capability built in for use with a third party push tool.

Other Features:

- All other features of Cornerstone Vista 2.0 should function as they did in version 7.0.0098 of Cornerstone, please refer to the latest manual for questions.
